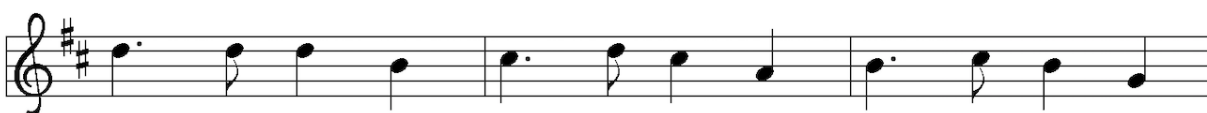
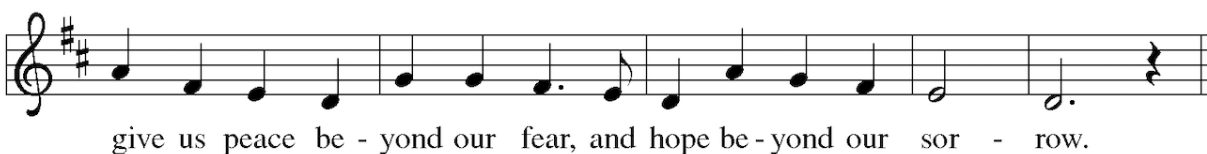
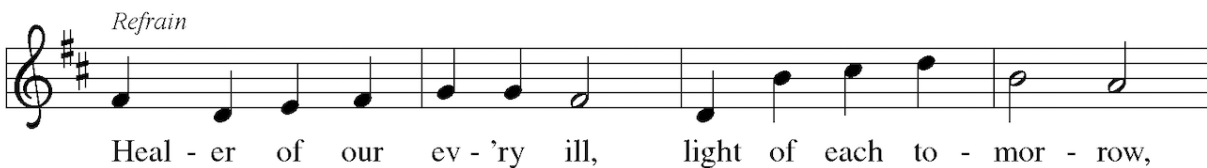
Psalm Prayer *(after a time of silence)*

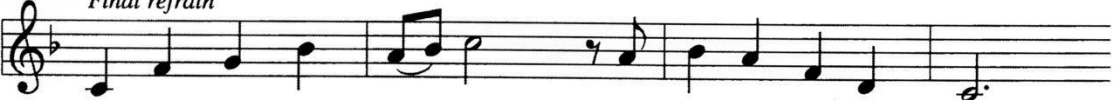
