



Job Description: Course Maintenance (Grounds Crew)

Employment Type:

Seasonal, Part-Time (Mid-April to Mid-October)

Hours:

20–30 hours per week (Minimum average of 20 hours/week required for free membership, cart lease, and range use)

Position Summary:

Grounds Crew members perform essential maintenance tasks to ensure the golf course is maintained at high standards. Duties include mowing, turf care, bunker maintenance, course setup, and general upkeep to enhance golfer experience and course presentation.

Key Responsibilities:

- Operate mowing equipment for fairways, greens, tees, roughs, and practice areas.
- Perform course setup tasks including changing cups and moving tee markers.
- Maintain and rake bunkers; ensure sand consistency and bunker edges are tidy.
- Assist with watering, fertilizing, and basic chemical applications as directed by Superintendent.
- Maintain driving range, including ball pickup and tee line maintenance.

- Identify and report any turf damage, hazards, or equipment issues immediately.
- Support preparations for tournaments and special club events.
- Maintain cleanliness and organization of maintenance facilities and equipment.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Must be at least 16 with a valid drivers license.
- Previous landscaping or golf course maintenance experience preferred, but not required.
- Ability to operate maintenance equipment and hand tools safely and effectively.
- Reliable, punctual, with strong attention to detail.
- Comfortable working outdoors in various weather conditions.
- Able to lift up to 50 pounds and perform physical tasks consistently.
