

DUCT TAPE THE KID

OBJECTIVE:

See who stays on the wall the longest after pulling the chair they stand on.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

1. One hoodie or long sleeved shirt for each student being taped
2. Lots of Duct Tape (at least 3 – 4 Large Rolls of Duct Tape per Team) or 5 – 6 Medium Rolls per team.
3. Each team will need a chair that is the same height.

TEAMS:

At least 2x teams

SETUP:

1. Pick at least 2 students to be taped, depending on supplies you have.

TIP: Smaller students will typically stay on the wall the longest.

2. Have the student to be Duct Taped put a hoodie on if needed to protect their hair from being duct taped on their head and arms.
3. Have them stand on a chair Next to the wall that they are to be taped to.

*****PLEASE READ*****

Make sure to test the wall you are taping the student to. Not all wall types will work. Walls with fabric on them DO NOT work. The wall needs to be a hard surface such as wood, concrete, or plastic for the students to get the best experience.

HOW TO PLAY:

1. When called, run up to your teammate as quickly as possible and start duct taping them. Have a leader or 2 per team if possible tearing Duct Tape strips off for the students. This makes the gameplay faster and more organized / efficient.
2. NO DUCT TAPING THE HAIR OR FACE (IT REALLY HURTS AFTER)
3. Call students up such as “everyone wearing red”, “wearing a hat”, “wearing shorts” and so on...
4. When time is up, have an adult leader PULL the chairs away at the same time.

Whoever stays stuck to the wall the longest is the winner!
