Today Pinkerton traveled to Mines Falls for the Nashua North Invitational on a hot Saturday under the blazing sun.

In the JV race, the Astros claimed the top 3 spots with Senior Captain Ava Mohammed winning in 22:31. This was a 56-second PR! Ava was closely followed by fellow Senior Captain Mia

Eckerman in 2nd (22:41), and Junior Priya Philipp in 3rd (22:59). Freshman Bridget Johnson completed the JV squad in 28:41.

In the Varsity race, the Astros used their intelligence to start conservatively and then run consistently to move up in the pack. This yielded excellent results. Sophomore Sookie Folsom finished 5th in 20:03. Junior Captain Gabby Bedard finished 11th in 20:43 with fellow Junior Kali Marzolf right behind in 20:52. Senior Althea LeBlanc ran a strong race for 15th (21:10). Junior Parker Knowlton showed great toughness, overcoming a minor fall on the warmup to finish 19th in 21:40. Rounding out the Varsity were Sarah Rzasa (22:45) and Abby Stienecker (23:24).

Placing 5 runners in the top 20 proved to be decisive for the Trailblazers as we claimed the team championship over Vermont's U-32 by a mere 19 points (61-80).
