

4 Biblical Worldview sermons to share AS ONE in Churches across Canada, September to October.

“The Lord said, ‘If as one people speaking the same language they have begun to do this, then nothing they plan to do will be impossible for them.’ (Genesis 11:6).

To assist our busy Pastors with options for an easier yoke we have provided:

- 1) The template below with ideas and guidance.
- 2) 4 taped 15 minute videos for Pastors to build on for their Sunday Sermons or to use for small groups Q/A sessions.

A biblical worldview is believing that:

- 1) Absolute moral truths exist. (Isaiah 5:20).
- 2) Such truth is defined by the Bible. (Ephesians 4:23).
- 3) We must have firm belief in Biblical religious social views. (John 8:31-32).

Benefits of knowing the absolute truth of the Bible:

- 1) Preservation from deception and protection from being swayed by the world.
- 2) Ability to defend the faith and share it with others.
- 3) Truth is Power to live a moral, victorious, and positive lifestyle with eternal security.

Sessions for sermons:

1. The Power and Relevance of the Bible. Dave Kalamen

- a) The Bible contains the absolute truth from God with information about Himself and His expectations of us. (2 Timothy 3:15-17).
- b) The continuous relevance of the Bible in all creation from its beginning and eternity. (Deuteronomy 8:3; Matthew 4:4).
- c) It reveals to us the history of Jesus. (Hebrews 13:8).

2. Creation and God's purpose for mankind. Pat Francis

- a) God remains our Creator of the universe and shall always be its Ruler. (Genesis 1:1-31; John 1:1-14; Colossians 1:12-18).
- b) God created us in His image and likeness to love Him and represent Him on earth.
- c) Humans are created in God's image and likeness (intelligent, powerful, creative, valued and valuable, born with purpose). (Genesis 1:26-28).

3. The Fall of Mankind and The Redemption of God. Femi Olawale

- a) The fall of mankind from the state of holiness (Genesis 3:1-14, Romans 6:23).
- b) We have redemption through the blood of Jesus Christ. (Ephesians 1:17).
- c) Faith in Jesus is the only way to be saved and go to Heaven (John 14:6).

4. Marriage and The Family. Rick Ciaramitaro

- a) Marriage is not just a human social contract, but a divinely instituted purpose-driven covenant established by God from the beginning of the creation of humans.
- b) First marriage ceremony was performed by God himself as minister, father and witness. (Genesis 2:23-25).
