

The Detroit Pistons lost 114-146 in the 2023-2024 NBA regular league away game against the Milwaukee Bucks at the Milwaukee Fiserv Forum in Wisconsin on the 17th (Korea time).

Cade Cunningham (25 points and six assists) fought hard, but it was not enough to face Milwaukee, which had 19 3-pointers. Detroit started the first quarter with seven consecutive runs, and never took a lead since. Detroit felt the power gap, losing 20-43 in the first quarter score, and ended the game without a significant counterattack.

As a result, Detroit lost 23 straight games. It is the sixth consecutive disgraceful record in a single season. The Cleveland Cavaliers (2010-2011 season) and the Philadelphia 76ers (2013-2014 season) are tied for first with 26 straight wins.

Detroit is tied for third with the Vancouver Grizzlies (1995-1996 season), the Denver Nuggets (1997-1998 season), and the Charlotte Bobcats (2011-2012 season). If he fails to break his losing streak at home against the Atlanta Hawks on the 19th, he will be disgraced as the third-ranked player.

Meanwhile, Philadelphia has the largest number of consecutive losses in two seasons. The team lost 28 consecutive games at the end of the 2014-2015 season and the beginning of the 2015-2016 season. Detroit's record of 23 consecutive losses is tied for fifth when two seasons of consecutive losses are included.
