

Register a GitHub Account


1. Sign up at <https://www.github.com>

2. You'll go through a few account setup and verification steps.

You can select "skip personalization" when it asks about team members.



3. When you're done, you should see a page like this:



Create Your ifspring2024 Repository

1. Click "Create Repository" in the left column
2. Repository name **must** be **ifspring2024**
3. Keep the repository "Public"

4. You **must** check “Add a README file”




5. Click “Create repository”

Set Up Your ifspring2024 GitHub Page

1. Click "Settings" on your "ifspring2024" repository page




2. Click the 'Pages' sub-tab in the left sidebar, then select 'main' for your Branch.




3. Click "Save"

4. After refreshing the page you should see your public URL. This may take a few minutes.



5. If you click on your URL it should look like this, although it may take a few minutes before your page is live.
