

Joining Accessible Library Networks

In order to get accessible content for students with disabilities, HEIs can facilitate students'/institute memberships to the following accessible library networks to get quick access to accessible content. In cases where the required content is not available on these platforms, the same would need to be converted.

I. Bookshare Membership - <https://www.bookshare.org/>

Bookshare provides individual memberships to all students and print-disabled teachers. They do not offer institutional memberships. Bookshare believes in empowering individuals with technology, and thus, we provide individual memberships to all eligible users free of cost.

To enrol qualified students, must fill the Individual Membership application, and submit the application form via email to zainabc@bookshare.org. The team will process memberships within 3 business days. Each student will receive a unique user ID and password for immediate access to the Bookshare platform.
