#### C. Guests / Person to be heard

- Guests
  - Kelly & Alvana Ballantyne
    - Expressed concerns about bell schedule limiting break times.
    - Compared to research on other local schools, with the current proposal our breaks would be shorter than those schools.
      - Stated that breaks allow learning time to feel more effective.
    - Explained that the break schedule and outdoor time is a major decision factor in choosing to come to Stream.
      - Feel specifically that the midday break does not allow enough time for both eating and playing.
    - Second concern about how to provide a safe place for students after school on Wednesdays.
      - Currently Alvana can walk home from school. Next year this will not always be possible.
      - Suggested having some kind of after school program options, such as a language club.
    - Asked if the school has reached out to indigenous ed.
  - Adam Mokolke response:
    - The bell schedule is not set, but understand the concern.
    - Open to, and encourages after school clubs.
    - Biggest hurdle is volunteer availability.
  - Sharon Wilson response:
    - Appreciative for research on local schools.
  - Jen Mickelson:
    - Encouraged Kelly & Alvana to reach out to the new director of indigenous ed.
  - Savanna Lethin:
    - Have we considered bringing back the Math club?
  - Adam Mokolke:
    - The challenge is the club was run by a staff member who needs that time for planning.

#### D. Reports

- Staff Liaison - Matt Wattendorf
  - Current events: Staff appreciation was much appreciated! School dance, teacher tales - Mr. B.
  - GL updates: showcase, rocket launch, plant sale, 8th grade camping trip, 6th grade field day at Camp Gorsuch, art club, yearbooks are here!
  - Teacher thoughts: keeping our identity through change and growth, how do we teach soft skills more intentionally.

- 501(c)3 Update - Jen Mickelson
  - Closed the auction Monday night! \$4700 raised.
    - Engagement level approximately equal to years past.
    - Pick up for baskets is on Saturday 5/17
    - Previous year donations included experiences over material things and tended to do a bit better. Next year, emphasize those kinds of donations.
    - Contemplating a year-long drive to improve the library space.
    - Excited about parent involvement in Friends of Stream.
    - Finishing the year with approximately \$2,900 in bank.
- Principal Report - Adam Mokolke
  - Primary focus: Transition team has been meeting every Tuesday. There is a live document with to-do items broken into phases. There are a lot of moving parts. Embracing the challenges of working more closely with ASD.
  - We are an approved CEP school. Students will receive breakfast and lunch.
  - Expressed intention to carve out more time for breaks.
  - Lottery: Some families missed the accept window. Took many of those families when necessary. Expect attrition to balance out enrollment.
  - District projected a revenue increase. Plan is to not make adjustments until revenues are more certain and the fiscal year opens.
  - Calendar waivers for PD days are expected to remain the same.
  - Martha Lojewski : What is our goal now with saving money.
  - Mokolke: I am not sure yet. We likely can continue a reserve. If nothing else, the funding uncertainty is the primary reason to keep/grow savings.
  - Wattendorf: With growth, will renovation be a major cost?
  - Mokolke: Major improvements may often be covered by ASD, but growth may come out of our budget at times.
  - Lojewski: Do you expect ASD to ask for/dictate/use our budget more now that we are in an ASD facility.
  - Mokolke: I do not know the answer. I expect with current admin major things will be covered by ASD, but also can not be sure.
  - Jen Mickelson: These are valid concerns. However, if we are true to our charter, we should hope ASD will allow us to operate as we have.
  - Sharon Wilson: Charter schools are currently showing good data for academic success, so leadership currently doesn't want to take that away.
  - Jen Mickelson: Might be time for an APC retreat to focus on next goals for STReAM.
  - Martha: It will also be important to add members to the APC. Maybe at the jump start?
  - Jen Mickelson: It may be time to consider adding a student rep.
