4.2 Number, Qualification, Election and Tenure: The number of Directors shall be the number of Directors elected from time to time in accordance with these Bylaws, but shall never be less than three (3). The number of Directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by the Board of Directors at any regular meeting of the Board. The Directors need not be residents of Idaho. Directors shall be elected at the annual and at any regular meeting of the Directors and shall serve until the next succeeding annual meeting and until their successors have been elected and qualified.

4.3 Ex-officio Members of the Board of Directors: The Board of Directors may designate Ex-officio members of the Board of Directors with rights to participate in the meetings [subject to the rule of the chairman], without the right to vote and without a right to participate in or be in attendance at any executive session.

4.4 Annual Meetings: The Board of Directors shall hold its annual meeting in October of each calendar year for the purpose of establishing the number and elections of members of the Board of Directors Ex-officio members of the Board of Directors and the election of Officers and the transaction of such other business.

Report dated 11/25/25 - Star continues to work hard on developing our pathway system. We recently applied for the COMPASS Communities in Motion Implementation Grant; which if we receive it, it will help fund a new pathway section connecting our primary sport complex to surrounding neighborhoods to the north that are severely lacking a safe and convenient non-motorized transportation route. We are also in the process of updating our CIP and impact fees, and are considering adding a new pathway impact fee into the mix. This new impact fee would be significant if it is does get approved because it would allow the city to collect impact fees specifically for building out our master pathway plan. Last but not least, road construction is everywhere and it will be commonplace for the next five plus years. I believe between ITD and ACHD, over \$300M will be invested into this area over the next five years for road improvements.
