

# Privacy Policy for TabIQ

## Overview

**TabIQ** (“we”, “our”, or “the extension”) is committed to protecting your privacy.

This Privacy Policy explains how TabIQ handles data when you use our Chrome extension.

**TL;DR:**

👉 We **don't collect, store, or transmit** any of your data. Everything stays **on your device**.

---

## 1. Data Collection

**TabIQ does NOT collect any personal data.**

We do not:


- ❌ Collect browsing history
  - ❌ Track your activity
  - ❌ Store personal information
  - ❌ Send data to external servers
  - ❌ Use cookies or tracking technologies
  - ❌ Integrate with third-party analytics services

## 2. Local Data Storage


TabIQ uses Chrome's local storage API (`chrome.storage.local`) to store certain information **on your device only**.

## Stored locally:


### 1. Tab Sessions / Collections

- Saved tab URLs, titles, and favicons
- Collection names and timestamps
-  Stored locally only

### 2. Tab Usage Metrics

- Tab open duration
- Last active timestamp
- Total active time
-  Stored locally for analytics display only

### 3. Extension Settings

- User preferences and configurations
-  Stored locally

**All data is stored locally on your device and never leaves your computer.**

## 3. Permissions Explained

TabIQ requires certain Chrome permissions to function properly.  
Here's what we use — and why:

### Required Permissions

Permission	Purpose	Usage	Storage
<code>tabs</code>	Read and manage open tabs	Display tab lists, close/pin/mute, categorize tabs	Real-time only
<code>storage</code>	Save data locally	Save and restore tab collections and metrics	Local storage
<code>windows</code>	Manage tabs per window	Enable per-window tab organization	Real-time only
<code>history</code>	Detect duplicate tabs	Compare URLs to avoid duplicates	Real-time only
<code>sessions</code>	Save/restore sessions	Enable Collections feature	Local storage
<code>sidePanel</code>	Display dashboard interface	Show TabIQ panel in Chrome UI	N/A
<code>system.memory</code>	Display memory stats	Show available RAM and usage %	Real-time only
<code>activeTab</code>	Access active tab after user gesture	Read title, URL, favicon for display	Real-time only

**Note:**

We do *not* request broad host permissions ([http://\\*\\*/\\*](http://**/*), [https://\\*\\*/\\*](https://**/*)).





TabIQ only accesses tab metadata (title, URL, favicon) when you interact with the extension. It never reads or accesses the actual webpage content.

## Optional Permissions

Permission	Purpose	Usage
<code>idle</code>	Detect idle state	Potential future feature for auto-saving

## 4. Data Transmission

TabIQ **does NOT transmit** any data externally.

-  No data is sent to servers
-  No data shared with third parties
-  No analytics or tracking
-  No external API calls

 Everything stays on your device.

---

## 5. Third-Party Services





TabIQ does **not** use or integrate any third-party services, including:

- Analytics (e.g., Google Analytics)
  - Ads or trackers
  - Crash reporting
  - Cloud storage or APIs
- 

## 6. Data Security

Since all data is stored locally, your privacy is protected by Chrome's built-in security.

Your data is:

-  Secured by Chrome's sandbox
-  Isolated from other extensions
-  Encrypted in local storage
-  Not accessible by anyone but you

## 7. Data Retention

Data Type	Retention	How to Delete
Tab Sessions / Collections	Until manually deleted	Delete within extension or uninstall
Usage Metrics	Stored locally until uninstall	Uninstall extension
Settings	Until uninstall	Uninstall extension

To delete all data:

➡ Go to <chrome://extensions/> → **TabIQ** → **Remove Extension**

---

## 8. Your Rights

Since no personal data is collected, there's nothing to access or delete.  
But you still have full control over local data:

- View data within the extension
  - Delete collections manually
  - Uninstall the extension to clear all data
- 

## 9. Children's Privacy

TabIQ does not knowingly collect information from children under 13.  
The extension is designed for general use and not targeted toward children.
