Hackman 124 - GIS Lab: Directions for Use

General Instructions

- 1. Locate the A/V box on the front right of the room.
- 2. Press the Display ON button. It will flash until the Whiteboard has warmed up.
- 3. Select your Source:
 - PC
 - HDMI
- 4. Control the volume by adjusting the Volume knob.

To project the Windows PC

- 1. Turn on the (Dell) Windows PC and monitor to the right of the rack.
- 2. Log-in using your F&M Net ID and password.
- 3. Press the PC source button.
- 4. Log-out when finished.

To Display a Laptop (HDMI)

- 1. Attach your laptop to the provided HDMI cable.
- 2. Press the HDMI source button.
- 3. When done, coil up the HDMI cable and place it back on its shelf.

To Play a DVD or Blu-Ray disc

- 1. Attach the HDMI cable to the back of the Blu-Ray player.
- 2. Press the HDMI source button.
- 3. Press the red Power button on LG remote to turn on the Blu-Ray/DVD player if need be.
- 4. Press the OPEN/CLOSE button on the LG remote or Blu-Ray/DVD player to eject the DVD tray.
- Insert the DVD or Blu-Ray disc.
- 6. Press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button again to close the tray.
- 7. Control the Blu-Ray/DVD player with the LG remote.
- 8. Detach the HDMI cable when done so it is ready for the next user.

To Use BrightLink Whiteboard

- 1. Select any Source OR Press the button on the Epson control box on the right side of the rack.
- 2. Once the BrightLink projector illuminates, click the electronic pen on the licon to see the vertical toolbar. You may also use your finger in place of the electronic pen.
- 3. At the top of the vertical toolbar , click the leftmost screen icon to mark up a Source (Source is selected at the podium touch screen). Click the rightmost screen icon to use the Whiteboard feature.
- 4. You can open a file from a USB drive to view, or mark up, OR Save a marked-up file to a USB drive from the BrightLink Screen. Insert the USB drive into the jack on the control box. Press the icon to Save to USB.
- 5. A Marked-up Source can also be Captured and saved. Press the icon to Capture. Save from Whiteboard.
- 6. A Saved marked-up file OR Whiteboard screen can also be sent to an email address. Press the icon to email a file. Enter your email address.
- 7. Click on the ? icon to get help with the Whiteboard Toolbars.

Shutdown

- 1. Press and hold the **Display OFF** button till it begins to flash, first green, then red. You can then release it. You will hear the Whiteboard fan stop and then a beep when it turns OFF.
- 2. Coil all cables up, neatly off the floor to prevent damage.
- 3. Place all electronic pens back in their holder on the rack.
- 4. Thoroughly erase any whiteboard marks for the next user of the projection system.
