2. Discussion.....Tiffany Leffler

- Tiffany Leffler read a handout of submitted questions with answers from Cara Wilber. Discussions followed.

- The Biomass is still a big budget concern. Lori Cheek explained more in depth how the Biomass works and the plan to reevaluate how payments are figured. The Biomass committee is working on a new business plan to make it more equitable between the owners.
- Emilie Glascock would like to see funds for a grant writer but if she had to choose between a HR person or a grant writer she would be satisfied with a HR person.
- Cara Wilber handed out the Harney County Treasurer Report and a revised report for Fund 230.

Rob Frank made a motion that the budget committee of the Harney County School district #3 approves taxes for the 2022-2023 fiscal year at the rate of \$4.8662 per \$1,000 of assessed value for operating purposes in the General Fund; and in the amount of \$212,100 for bonds; and approved the budget in the amount of \$19,121,506 for the entire operations of the District, which includes changes noted to Fund 101 and Fund 230. Lori Cheek seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
