

Non-Member Student Policies: (BHBA, Registration & Enrollment)

Beth Haven Baptist Academy will accept students from churches of *like faith* and *like practices*. Decisions to accept students are based upon the following guidelines:

1. The student and at least one parent must be faithful members of an independent Baptist Church with a similar doctrinal statement.
2. The pastor of their church must submit a letter of recommendation.
3. The student and parent must agree with and adhere to the Bylaws, Articles of Faith and Church Covenant of Beth Haven Baptist Church.
4. The student and parent must read and agree to the policies contained in the school handbook.
5. The student and parent will meet with the principal prior to acceptance.
6. The student and parent must fill out and sign all the required registration documents.

Statement of Purpose:

According to our Statement of Faith, the purpose of the church is *to make individual disciples, to build up the church and to teach and to instruct as Christ has commanded*. Our purpose as a school is to put this purpose into action. We will strive to accomplish our purpose through faithful adherence to the following three-fold plan. First, by having Bible classes daily to present God's will for all children to be saved and leading them to Christ when they reach the point of understanding and desiring to be saved. Secondly, by teaching them to love God and to love the pursuit of truth and wisdom. All truth comes from God, be it religious or scientific. Thirdly, by training them to be people of character, to think deeply and rightly, to develop great attitudes, and to develop wholesome emotional, mental, verbal and physical responses. In other words, to live out the gospel lifestyle.
