Position of adjectives

An adjective can be put **before a noun** in a sentence.

It can also be put **after a noun** in a sentence.

She gifted me a **blue** shirt. (Adjective **blue** before the noun **shirt**)

The earth is **round**. (objective **round** comes after the noun **earth**)
