## **Recommendation Instructions**

### for SAIL Award Nominees in 2025

"S" stands for "Superior"; "A" stands for "Applicative"; "I" stands for "Innovative"; "L" stands for "Leading". The SAIL Award is mainly designed to recognize outstanding projects in the field of artificial intelligence that have made directional technological breakthroughs, applied innovations, and are changing or will change future lives globally. The SAIL selection includes the SAIL Awards and the annual SAIL TOP 30 list. Projects participating in the SAIL Award selection should meet the following criteria:

1. Nominated projects should be innovative achievements that have been publicly released by the end of March 2025.

- 2. The applicant unit of the nominated project should be an enterprise or a research or academic team with significant breakthroughs in artificial intelligence technology.
- 3. The same enterprise or unit is permitted to submit merely one project and is prohibited from repeatedly applying for the same project in successive years.
- 4. Technical projects are preferred to nominate teams with significant breakthroughs for selection, such as teams that have obtained international or domestic invention patents, or have published papers in top artificial intelligence journals or conferences (e.g., ACL, EMNLP, IJCAI, ICML, etc.), or have won awards in international artificial intelligence competitions (e.g., Kaggle, Cvpr etc.).
- 5. Application-oriented projects are preferred to nominate projects that are integrated with application scenarios, have been



implemented, and have strong industry influence and innovative benchmark significance.

6. The project should have no disputes in terms of intellectual property ownership and business operation models.
