May 1	DEADLINE to submit Statement of Intent to Register at UCI (SIR)	Submit your Statement of Intent to Register, with your Acceptance of Admission Fee, and your Statement of Legal Residence (if applicable) via the UCI Applicant Portal .
May 1	DEADLINE to respond to your Campuswide Honors Collegium Invitation	Respond to your Campuswide Honors Collegium invitation via the UCI Applicant Portal . We hope you will accept!
May 1	Financial Aid and Scholarships priority DEADLINE	Priority deadline for UCI to receive all required supporting documents to complete students' financial aid applications.
May 2*	DEADLINE to submit on-campus housing application	Submit your online on-campus housing application (and processing fee). For more information, visit https://housing.uci.edu/first-year/ * Your SIR must be submitted before you can apply for on-campus housing. Allow 24 hours after SIR submission before applying for housing.

EARLY-BIRD WINDOW May 30 at 4:00 p.m. through June 4 at 3:59 p.m. Pacific Time <i>More information will be emailed to students in May</i>	Sign up for MANDATORY summer orientation (SPOP)	Summer orientation on campus is required for all UCI first years and includes academic advising, program planning, and enrollment in classes. Sign up as soon as possible during the Campuswide Honors priority period via www.orientation.uci.edu . <u>Campuswide Honors students are required to attend the Student Parent Orientation Program (SPOP) 1 or 2 in order to take advantage of priority registration since you will enroll in fall classes at summer orientation. Students attending Summer Bridge, the CAMP program, or International SPOP are authorized to not attend SPOP 1 or 2 in order to receive orientation at a later date through their respective summer programs.</u>

Attend an early priority summer orientation (SPOP)

Summer orientation is required for all UCI first-year students. CHC students must attend Student Parent Orientation Program (SPOP) 1 or 2 in order to take advantage of priority registration since you will enroll in fall classes at this required summer orientation. Opportunities to meet with CHC staff and current students will be offered at SPOP 1 and 2.

Summer

Early June

Submit your on-campus housing contract and Personal Information (PI) Form

Housing contract offers will be emailed in early June. Follow the instructions to accept your contract and submit the reservation fee by the deadline indicated.
If you wish to live in Honors Housing, be sure to indicate that theme preference on your Personal Information (PI) Form.

In June

Submit standardized test scores as soon as possible, if available.

If you have taken standardized tests (optional), please submit AP, IB, SAT, and ACT test scores to UCI as soon as possible, to satisfy the UC Entry Level Writing Requirement.

July 1

DEADLINE to submit official final transcripts to UCI

All official final transcripts (high school and college) must be received by the Office of Admissions BY July 1 so that you can remain eligible to attend UC Irvine. Transcripts for any summer classes for which you enroll are due to UCI BY Sept. 15. NOTE: NOT POSTMARK DEADLINES. For submission information, see:

DEADLINE to pay fees for Fall Quarter

If fees are not paid on the due date, courses will be dropped and financial penalties incurred.
NOTE: NOT A POSTMARK DEADLINE.
**Must be completed prior to close of business day. If paying at Central Cashier, by 4:00 p.m. PT. If paying online, prior to 5:00 p.m. PT.*

Mid to Late Sept.	Move in to on-campus residence halls	Housing and roommate assignments will be emailed by the second week of Sept. for students living in on-campus housing. Move-in information will be made available online in early Sept.
Sept. 25-27	Welcome Week	Information about <u>MANDATORY</u> Campuswide Honors Fall Orientation for first-year students will be mailed in early Sept.
Sept. 28	First day of classes	For Fall Quarter, 2023
