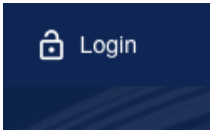




MackinVia is our digital library where you can find free ebooks and digital audiobooks provided by AMSA Library and other Anoka-Hennepin middle schools. Books can be checked out and downloaded for offline reading.

To access the digital library:

- Must be an AH middle school student to access.
- On your Chromebook through the RapidIdentity
- On another device through the MackinVia App (select and load through the App store)
- Login with your username and password (do not include @ahschools.us)

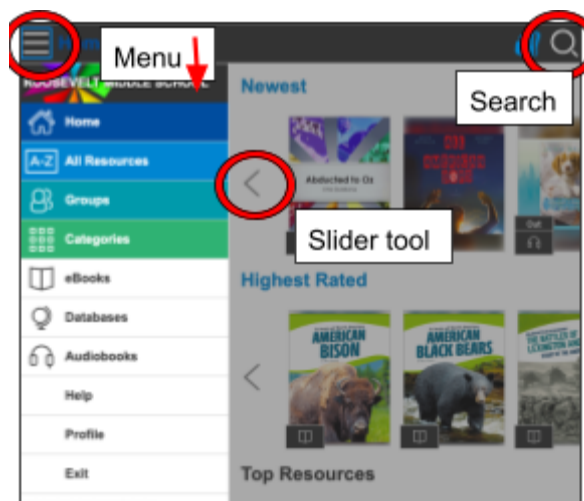

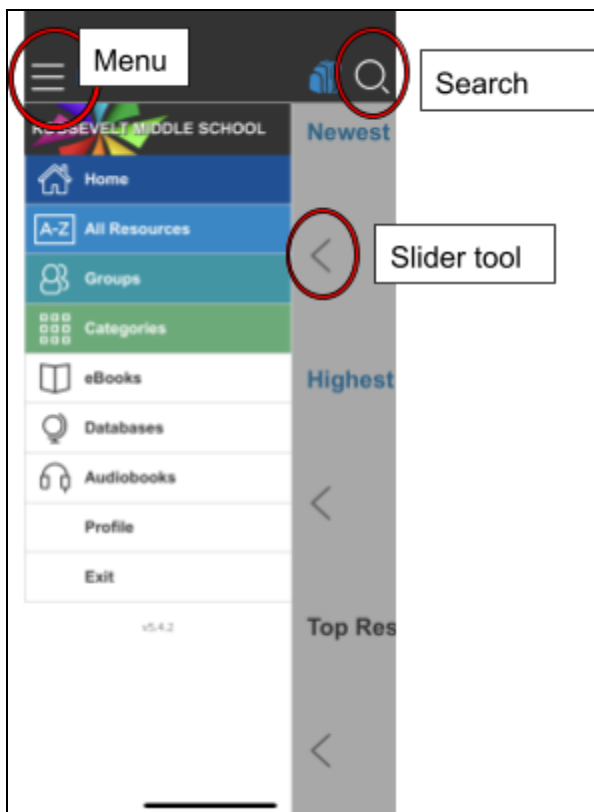

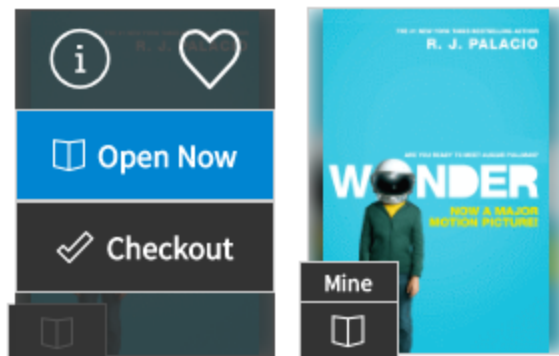


5. Hover over the book you wish to read. You have 2 options for reading/listening.

 - b. If you wish to have continued access, you should **Checkout** the book so that other users cannot prevent your

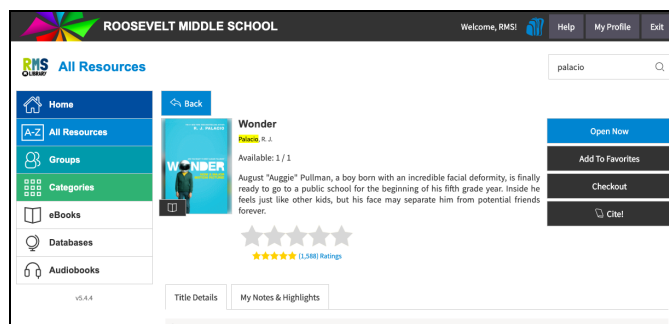
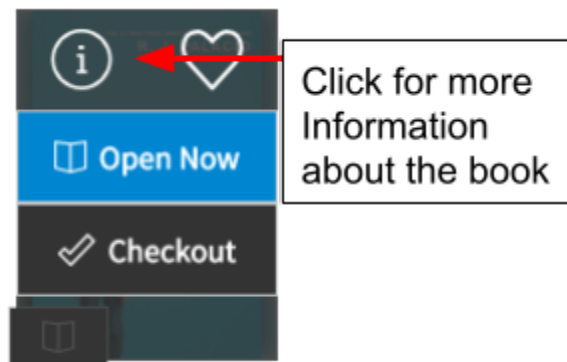


6. Select the book you wish to read. You have 3 options for reading/listening.

 - c. Once it is checked out, you can also **Download** the book for offline reading.

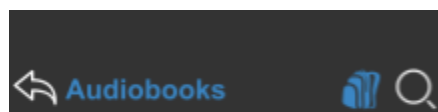

Once checked out, you can download the book for offline use.

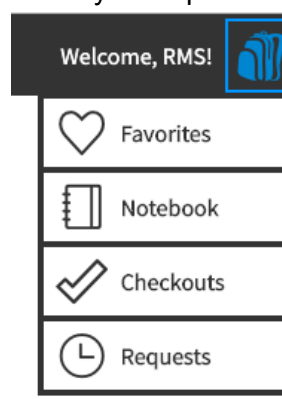


7. If a book is already checked out by another user, you can place a hold on it by selecting **Request**. Once the book is available, you will receive a notification.

11. The book will remain on your account for 21 days and then automatically be removed. If

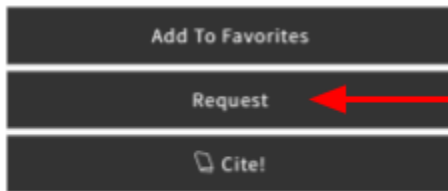

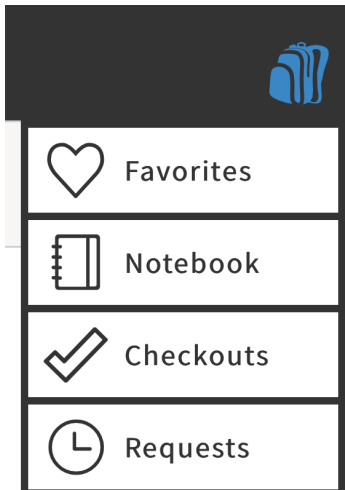
