The purpose of the Area I Region III BPA Scholarship Program is to provide financial assistance to the most capable and deserving members in our area wishing to pursue post-secondary education in preparation for a career in the business industry.

The selection of candidates is done on a competitive basis. The criteria used in selecting scholarship recipients will include:

1. Academic achievement
2. Number of business courses or related instruction
3. BPA membership (participation and achievement)
4. Personal Statement & Advisor Statement
5. Technical Merit

Applications must be submitted to the Regional Advisors by the date specified below. Upon evaluating the applicants, the Regional Advisors will score the applicants based on the attached rubric. The Regional Advisors will compile scores and the highest scores will receive the scholarships.

Funds will be sent to the recipient upon completion of the fall semester 2024 when a copy of their grade report is submitted to the Regional Advisor. It is mandatory that the scholarship recipient attend college/university/technical school the fall semester 2024.

The final date to request for scholarship funds will be March 31, 2025.

Area I Region III BPA Scholarship Eligibility and Requirements

To be eligible to apply for an Area I Region III BPA Scholarship, an applicant must:

- A. Be an active member of the Texas BPA Association for the current year.
- B. Be a current year graduating senior.
- C. Must have a combined three year total of CTE/technical courses (business, computer science, marketing, engineering, etc,) and active BPA membership (as proven with RLC competitions, torch awards, officer, etc) during grades 9 through 12.
- D. Submit the most current Area I Region III Scholarship Application.

The Area I Region III BPA Scholarship Applicant must:

- A. Have all applicable pages completed.
- B. APPLICATION TYPEWRITTEN, EXCEPT FOR SIGNATURES.**
- C. Contain all requested signatures.
- D. Contain only requested information, no extra supplemental pages.
- E. Submit the following with application:
 - 1. Unofficial transcript for the first three and one-half (3.5) years of high school
 - a. Include the **unweighted numerical high school grade average**
 - b. Signed by a school records official (principal, counselor, registrar, etc.)
 - 2. Student's Letter to the Regional Advisors, as instructed on page 4.
 - 3. Video response to the following prompt
 - a. How will your BPA experience impact your future?
