On behalf of the membership, I want to thank you for the work you’ve put in, the direction you’ve provided, and the energy you’ve invested in the club over these past six years. We wish you all the best as you step down from the presidency, and we hope that now you’ll have a bit more time to do what brought most of us here in the first place — getting outdoors and enjoying a range of different activities. Please join me in thanking Ruth for her six years as president.”
