Fall 2025 Class Descriptions

7th-12th Grade

A - Class Hour 1: Mind, Body, Spirit Wellness - Mr. Skyler Bascom (Rm 10/Outside)

Mind Body Spirit Wellness will be a hands-on approach to wellness, health and healing. Students will learn hands on practices such as centering prayer, breathwork, CrossFit, psychoeducation, the need for disciplines and fascinating facts of how God has made humans interconnected through the mind, body, and Spirit!

Supply Fee: \$8

A - Class Hour 1: Adult Skills - Mrs. Natalie Auterberry (Rm 9)

"Adulting" 101. Learn to make phone calls, schedule appointments, meal plan on a budget, email etiquette, car insurance basics, resume writing, and more.

Supply Fee: \$10

B - Class Hour 2: The Science of Hydrology - Mr. Scott Kenner (Rm 1)

This class will be a study of hydrology and how we manage water resources. With hydrologic science we will build math skills, use of internet resources for water resources information and as much as possible building computer skills.

Students will explore the <u>hydrologic cycle</u>, learn about precipitation, <u>runoff</u>, <u>groundwater</u>, and <u>surface water</u>, and potentially delve into water usage, conservation, and related issues.

B - Class Hour 2: Art: Mosaics - Mrs. Jessica Baas (Rm 9)

Explore a unique art medium of mosaic making, arranging small pieces of stone, ceramic, glass, or found objects. Learn about ancient pebble mosaics, Greco-Roman floor mosaics, and contemporary Pique Assiette "Broken China" mosaic. Make some one-of-a-kind artworks with proper tools and techniques, especially a fun one make with recycled and found materials. Each student will complete three projects, two being perfect for beginners and one to show their new skills. Tools will be provided for sharing, or each student can bring their own tile nippers.

C - Class Hour 3: Spanish - Mrs. Meagan Green (Rm 9)

An introductory class to the Spanish language using songs and stories, and games with questions and answers.

C - Class Hour 3: Latin Pt.1 - Mrs. Cydney Macomber (Chapel)

Learn Latin and strengthen English grammar skills while going through Wheelock's Latin textbook. We will memorize New Testament verses in Latin and read fairy tales in Latin.

A - Class Hour 1 (option 1): Volleyball - Mrs. Lindsay Christie (Outside/FH)

Learn the basics of volleyball. Pass. Set. Serve!

A - Class Hour 1 (option 2): <u>Jump for Joy!</u> - Mrs. Gabby Gale (Outside/Lobby)

In this class students will learn to basics of jumping rope, tricks, skills, and double dutch. Our goal will be putting together a routine to show off during presentation night.

B - Class Hour 2 (option 1): <u>Junior Detective</u> - Mrs. Lindsay Christie (Rm 8, 3 or chapel?)

Join our Junior Detective class, where young sleuths will learn the skills to crack mysteries and solve puzzles. Inspired by the popular board game, students will develop critical thinking, observation, and problem-solving skills through interactive games, challenges, and activities. From gathering clues to piecing together the evidence, our junior detectives will become masters of deduction and have a blast doing it!

B - Class Hour 2 (option 2): Art - Mrs. Heaven Butchart (Rm 7)

Explore new art techniques using various forms of materials, including paint, sculpting with clay, and so much more.

C - Class Hour 3 (option 1): <u>Motion and Simple Machines</u> - Mrs. Meaghan Lundeen (Rm 3?)

In this coarse students will discover the laws of motion, force, gravity, and simple machines. As a former high school math teacher I feel that our kids need (and often lack) a strong foundation in these basics principles of physics. Understanding these concepts and the role they play in our world lays the groundwork for many topics in STEM education. To keep the learning fun and experimental we will use the "Motions"

and Simple Machines" curriculum from The Good and The Beautiful as an outline for time together. Motion and Simple Machines – The Good and the Beautiful
