

TLG Treatment Rep (Treatment Committee Member)

To represent your Home Group on the District 5 Treatment Committee, as a way of carrying the message outside of your group.

Treatment Committee Liaison: Some groups have treatment representatives who serve as the group liaison with the local intergroup (central office), district or area treatment committee. They share this vital service work with home group members and encourage them to join in this responsibility. AA Group Pamphlet page 25-26

Qualifications:

- 1 year sobriety/1 year term
- A working knowledge of the 12 Traditions or have a Service Sponsor

Responsibilities:

- Attend the District 5 Treatment Committee meetings.
- Attend TLG monthly business meetings and provide a report.
- Encourage qualified members of your group to get involved in going into your facility with you.
- Bring flyers from local A.A. events into the treatment centers with you.
- Starting one month before you rotate out of this position, start announcing that the position will be open and when.
- When the next member is elected, attend their first Treatment Committee meeting with them and introducing them to the committee. Explain their duties to them by going over this list and help them to learn the ropes.
