## Elisha's Voice to Modern Business Leaders: A Prophetic Call Through the Lens of Abundant Life Family Care

## Part I: Elisha Through the Eyes of Christ - The Prophet of Radical Multiplication and Kingdom Economics

  - The oil kept flowing as long as there were empty vessels a principle of limitless provision tied to prepared capacity
- 3. The Shunammite Woman's Dead Son Raised (2 Kings 4:18-37)
  - Showed that Kingdom authority extends over death itself
  - o Demonstrated intimate, personal care he didn't send a servant; he went himself
  - Parallels Christ's raising of the widow's son at Nain
- 4. Feeding 100 Men with 20 Loaves (2 Kings 4:42-44)
  - Prefigured Christ's feeding of the 5,000
  - Demonstrated radical generosity in scarcity
  - "They shall eat and have some left over" the Kingdom principle of abundance
- 5. Healing Naaman the Syrian (2 Kings 5:1-19)
  - Refused payment for God's healing power
  - Demonstrated that the Kingdom transcends national boundaries

- Rebuked the monetization of spiritual authority (contrast with Gehazi's greed)
- 6. The Floating Axe Head (2 Kings 6:1-7)
  - Cared about a borrowed tool of a poor prophet
  - Showed God's concern for economic justice and the working poor
  - Demonstrated supernatural intervention in everyday economics

# Part II: Elisha's Message to American Business Leaders Today

## To Christian Business Leaders Specifically:

Standing before today's Christian business elite, Elisha would thunder with prophetic authority:

### "You have built towers of Babel and called them blessings!"

"Where are your foster children? Where are your widows? Where are your refugees? You tithe from abundance while children sleep in government shelters! You debate theology in your men's groups while trafficking victims await rescue with no homes prepared for them!"

But know this: every resource you hoard while children suffer is a judgment stored up. The refugee you ignore today may have been the innovation your company needed tomorrow. The foster child you overlook might have been the leader your industry required."

## Part III: Elisha's Rebuke to Podcast-Consuming Christians

With holy fire, Elisha would confront the modern Christian podcast culture:

### "You have become professional hearers of the Word but amateur doers!"

"You consume 10 hours of sermons weekly but won't spend 1 hour with an orphan! You debate predestination while predetermined children wait for homes! You parse Greek words while ignoring plain English: 'Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction!""

- 3. **To the Prophecy and End-Times Enthusiasts:** "You map out tribulation timelines while creating tribulation for children through your inaction! You prepare for the Antichrist while becoming anti-Christ in your apathy toward 'the least of these!"

## Part IV: Elisha's Specific Questions for Today's Business Leaders

## The Seven Prophetic Interrogations:

- 1. **"Show me your vessels"** (referencing 2 Kings 4:3)
  - "How many empty homes do you have that could house foster children?"

  - "Do you want a platform miracle or a private obedience?"
  - "Will you do the simple, unglamorous thing God requires?"
- 4. "Where are your borrowed axes?" (referencing 2 Kings 6:5)
  - "What have you borrowed from the next generation that you're not returning?"
  - "What tools of justice and mercy have sunk in your river of comfort?"
  - "When did you last intervene supernaturally for someone else's economic crisis?"
- 5. "What do you have in your house?" (referencing 2 Kings 4:2)
  - "Inventory your resources not for your benefit but for multiplication"
  - o "That small jar of oil (your business) is it for hoarding or pouring?"

- "Will you stop pouring when God is still multiplying?"
- 6. **"Do you see the horses and chariots?"** (referencing 2 Kings 6:17)
  - "Can you see the supernatural potential of foster care as Kingdom warfare?"
  - "Do you recognize that every Grace Home is a military outpost against darkness?"
  - "Are your eyes open to the angelic economics available through radical generosity?"
- 7. "Will you take the money?" (referencing 2 Kings 5:15-16)
  - "Can you do Kingdom work without monetizing it?"
  - "Will you refuse profit from what God freely gave?"
  - "Can you bless without building your brand?"

## Part V: Elisha's Prophetic Declaration Over ALFC

Standing over the Abundant Life Family Care vision, Elisha would declare:

### "THIS is the multiplication chamber I have longed to see!"

- 4. **The Syrian Blindness:** "I prayed for enemy armies to be struck blind, but you've blinded yourselves! You can't see the foster children, the refugees, the widows! You're

- surrounded by Kingdom opportunities but stumble in spiritual darkness!" (referencing 2 Kings 6:18)
- 5. The Dothan Deafness: "At Dothan, I opened the servant's eyes to see heaven's armies. But you've closed your eyes to heaven's economics! You can't hear the cries of 400,000 foster children over the sound of your stock portfolios climbing!"
