Influential role models for Starkey's work--John Dewey, Rene Cassin, and Eleanor Roosevelt; Key quote from the Preamble to the UDHR; Sums up the key concepts (freedom, justice and peace) that constitute the ideal evident in the UDHR; Recommendation to advance HRE would be to require HRE in all teacher training programs and assess candidate understanding of human rights; In UK, the central government would need to act to mandate his recommendation; Importance of educating teachers in higher education who would teach HRE to prospective classroom educators.
