- 3. We keep the list below as up to date as possible, but there may be a 1-2 day lag.
- 4. If nothing below works for you, submit a <u>Group Project Request Form</u> and let us know your availability; we may be able to find a project for your team. It will take us 1-3 weeks (2-4 weeks in the spring) to work out the details with our staff in the field.
