    - Ashley indicates she is interested if she could learn more

## **3:45 pm** Competitive Applications Vote (Paul Brown)

- All applicants are current grantees:
  - Four applicants Recompeting for an additional 3-year funding cycle
  - Three Applicants applying for Continuation (currently in Year 1 or 2 of 3-year cycle)
  - Six current Formula grantees
    - What is the success rate?
    - 2-3 years ago we had basically all our applications approved
    - 12 months ago, there was a very tight competition that we didn't do great with. Not a single competitive repeat



- What is downside to putting all apps up for competitive?
  - Good question we can discuss further in the future if commissioners want

    - Mary: Is there anything we should be mindful of when looking at these applications?
      - AmeriCorps raised the minimum amount that members can make by \$2,000
      - Serve and AmeriCorps agency are working on raising minimum allowance
