On 2 January 2014 the Freegle TSW Team published the <u>Freegle IPS Director Role Description</u> on <u>Freegle UK Central</u>. Questions regarding this role description were requested. The questions that have since been asked are as follows.

## **Online Board Meetings**

## Question

<u>Kathryn Speight</u>: The document mentions regular board meetings. I'm presuming that this refers to online board meetings.

#### **Answer**

Edward Hibbert [TSW]: Yes, the board meetings will be conducted online.

## **Medium of Board Meetings**

#### Question

<u>Kathryn Speight</u>: How will these meetings take place? Will it be through the Reps Yahoo group, another Yahoo group set up just for this purpose, or will another online medium be used?

#### **Answer**

<u>Edward Hibbert [TSW]</u>: That's for the Directors to decide amongst themselves. But I would encourage an online conference of some sort - phone, perhaps with an electronic whiteboard. It is less likely to be a general ongoing discussion than the current Reps group is, and more like a standard Board where there are papers for the Board to discuss and approve/modify/reject. If we wanted to have Board members from outside the current organisation (which we might, for skills and contacts) then this is the format which they would be used to.

## **TSW Acronym**

#### Question

Kathryn Speight: What does TSW stand for?

## **Answer**

Edward Hibbert [TSW]: It was something like "Trading Subsidiary Working" group, but early on we reported that a subsidiary wasn't the way to go, so now the name is a bit daft.

## **Nomination of Candidates**

### Question

<u>Kathryn Speight</u>: Do people apply themselves or do they have to be nominated? If they apply themselves, who do they apply to?

#### **Answer**

Edward Hibbert [TSW]: I don't think we've specified in the Freegle Trading Subsidiary Working Group Final Report what the precise mechanism is, so I'm expecting that the Returning Officer will clarify that.

<u>Paul Thompson [Returning Officer]</u>: I expect it would be best to use the same process as normal with a few modifications to accommodate the possibility of the election of board members from outside of the organisation. I would propose we use something like the following:

- 1. Nominations may be made via <u>Freegle Central</u> or directly to the <u>Returning Officer email</u> address.
- 2. Nominations should include the individual's name and email address. In the event of the nominee being a volunteer with a Freegle group, their primary group should be provided. In the event of another individual being nominated, any relevant group membership should be noted (i.e. a member of the National Cooperative's Council).
- 3. Nominations should be seconded. This can occur on either <u>Freegle Central</u> or directly to the Returning Officer email address.
- 4. All nominations will be confirmed by the Returning Officer to the candidate, seconder and to <u>Freegle Central</u> (regardless of where the nomination was sent).
