# **GENERAL MEETING MINUTES**

#### **CALL TO ORDER**

#### PRINCIPAL'S UPDATES:

Principal - Dr. Poteet reported on previous events, upcoming events and general announcements.

The students will have the opportunity to invest real money provided by the Quest Educational Foundation and possibly receive a portion of the profits when they graduate. This workshop is open to all students. Attendance is mandatory.
