We are asking for your union's support to build [UN AntiRacism Day demonstrations](#) in [London](#) and [Glasgow](#) (**Saturday 19 March**) and [Cardiff](#) (**Sunday 20 March**) organised by the TUC and Stand Up To Racism, as part of a [global day of anti racist protest](#).

We also thank you for all your union's support in building the [Fighting for Anti Racist Workplaces online conference being organised by the TUC and Stand Up To Racism on Saturday 5 February](#) which was organised to help maximise the trade union turnout on the 19 & 20 March protests. Over 1,100 trade unionists and anti racists registered and attended across the plenaries and workshops. 3. Can you **send your press and social media organisers to a meeting** we will facilitate in the coming weeks (details to follow) to plan press and social media strategies to maximise the turn out on 19/20 March?
4. Can you **confirm** that **your union's logo can be added** to the publicity for all three demonstrations, and the trade union conference?

5. Can your union **provide an official speaker**, whether the general secretary or a representative, for the **London demonstration** (and if able, provide speakers in Scotland and Wales)?

6. Can your general secretary, or a national representative of your union, **provide a one minute promotional video** highlighting why the demonstrations are important and urging people to attend?

7. Can your union **provide help with stewarding** on the days. Please send any details of stewards for London, Glasgow and Cardiff to us at info@standuptoracism.org.uk. The stewards meeting for the London march will take place at 6pm on Wednesday 16 March (online). More details to follow.

8. Can your union **provide a financial donation** to contribute to the cost of this year's event along with other trade unions?

As in previous years, the TUC can co-ordinate the financial arrangements on behalf of trade unions. Contributions made through the TUC will be paid to suppliers.
