

SPECIFIC RULES – WIN THE ULTIMATE MOTOGP GURU PADDOCK EXPERIENCE

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 These are the SPECIFIC RULES (“**Specific Rules**”) of MotoGP Guru’s “Win The Ultimate MotoGP Guru Paddock Experience” (“**Promotion**”) as offered by [WePlay Media LLC] (“**WePlay**”, “**we**”, “**us**” or “**our**”) and these Specific Rules constitute a legal binding agreement made between you, whether personally or on behalf of an entity (“**you**”) and [WePlay Media LLC] (“**WePlay**”, “**we**”, “**us**” or “**our**”) concerning your participation in the Promotion.
- 1.2 In addition to the Specific Rules, please refer to the general terms and conditions (“**Terms and Conditions**” and together with the Specific Rules, the “**Promotion Terms and Conditions**”) on our website motogpguru.com (“**Website**”). If any Specific Rules conflict with the Terms and Conditions, the Specific Rules will prevail.

WE ARE ONLY WILLING TO MAKE THE PROMOTION AVAILABLE TO YOU IF YOU ACCEPT THE PROMOTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS. BY PARTICIPATING IN THE PROMOTION, YOU ARE CONFIRMING THAT YOU HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND, AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE PROMOTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE OR ACCEPT THE PROMOTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS, THEN YOU ARE EXPRESSLY PROHIBITED FROM PARTICIPATING IN THE PROMOTION AND YOU MUST DISCONTINUE SUCH PARTICIPATION IMMEDIATELY.

WE MAY AMEND THESE PROMOTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS FROM TIME TO TIME BY POSTING THE UPDATED PROMOTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS ON THIS PAGE. BY CHOOSING TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROMOTION AFTER THE CHANGES COME INTO EFFECT MEANS THAT YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE UPDATED PROMOTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

2. HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- 2.1 This Promotion is available to participants who are at least 12 years old at the time of entry into the Promotion (an “**Eligible Participant**”).
- 2.2 There is no fee payable to enter this Promotion.
- 2.3 In order to participate in this Promotion, you must:
 - (a) scan a QR code which is unique to each MotoGP World Championship event and which will be publicized on posters, promotional material, ads and other forms of media, or log into the event specific website and create a user account;
 - (b) check the “accept terms and conditions” and the “Enter the Ultimate MotoGP Guru Paddock Experience” on the home page; and
 - (c) complete a round of the game by choosing the MotoGP riders whom you believe will prevail in each of the listed MotoGP World Championship event.

3. ENTRY PERIOD

- 3.1 The entry periods are divided into three specific periods for each round of the MotoGP World Championship: (1) the Friday prize round ("**Friday Prize Round**"), (2) the Saturday prize round ("**Saturday Prize Round**") and (3) the Sunday prize round ("**Sunday Prize Round**"). [Unless otherwise stated, all times will be based on UK time.]
- 3.2 The Friday Prize Round will open at 9:00 AM on the Monday prior to each round of the MotoGP World Championship and close at 4:00 PM on the Thursday immediately prior to Friday commencement of that round of the MotoGP World Championship.
- 3.3 The Saturday Prize round will open at 4:01 PM local time on the Thursday immediately prior that round of the MotoGP World Championship and close at 4:00 PM on the Friday of that round of the MotoGP World Championship.
- 3.4 The Sunday Prize round will open at 4.01 PM local time on the Friday immediately prior that round of the MotoGP World Championship and close at 4:00 PM on the Saturday of that round of the MotoGP World Championship.

4. CHOOSING AND ANNOUNCING THE WINNER

- 4.1 The winner will be drawn randomly from all entries by our representative in conjunction with an independent judge and announced through the MotoGP social channels and on the social channels of the MotoGP Guru and the Website.
- 4.2 The winner will be contacted only via the phone number and email address provided during initial entry.
- 4.3 The winner must be an Eligible Participant.
- 4.4 If it is determined that the winner is not an Eligible Participant or has breached any of the rules in the Promotion Terms and Conditions, a new winner will be selected until such time a valid winner is found.
- 4.5 For every weekend of the Promotion, there will be 4 winners announced for each of the Friday Prize Round, Saturday Prize Round and Sunday Prize Round.
- 4.6 Each winner will receive two (2) MotoGP Guru Paddock Experience's ("**Prize**") – for a total of 8 individual winners each day. The Prize will include paddock entry, hospitality with the Gresini Racing Team, a swag bag of event merchandise, a visit to the Gresini Racing Box, a meet and greet with the Gresini riders, access to the access road of the circuit and other experiences which may be unique to the MotoGP World Championship.
- 4.7 Each Eligible Participant will only be entitled to win one Prize each weekend. If an Eligible Participant's name is drawn more than once over a weekend of the Promotion, a new winner will be selected until such time a valid winner is found.

5. VERIFYING THE WINNER

- 5.1 Each winner must produce a passport or valid national Identification Document with photograph to be able to claim the Prize.

- 5.2 Any correspondence with each winner will only be via the phone number and email address provided during initial entry.
- 5.3 The winner must have a valid Gryfyn Wallet at the time of announcement and in order to claim the Prize.
- 5.4 If the winner does not produce evidence in accordance with paragraph 5.1 above to verify their identity, they will be disqualified and a new winner will be selected until such time a valid winner is found.

6. DELIVERY OF PRIZE

- 6.1 The Prize will be delivered to the winner at the paddock entrance of the MotoGP World Championship at 9:00 AM on either the Friday, Saturday or Sunday of the race weekend. Each winner will receive by email and text advising him or her of specific instructions to collect the Prize.
- 6.2 The Prize does not include the cost of transport and each winner is solely responsible for his or her own transportation costs and any other related expenses for attending the MotoGP World Championship for the claiming of the Prize.
- 6.3 On the day of claiming of the Prize, the winner must provide his or her valid proof of identity.
- 6.4 The winner must agree to participate in promotional activities with us and our partners including but not limited to video, photography, press, social media and other forms of promotion.
- 6.5 The winner must abide by all standards of behavior and decorum as set out in the notice provided to winners.

7. TAXES, DUTIES AND FEES

- 7.1 The winner is responsible for all duties, taxes and any fees levied by his or her government in the awarding of the Prize should there be any.

8. A WINNER MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN

- 8.1 We understand that Eligible Participants may enter the Promotion while not being physically present at the town or near the circuit where the MotoGP World Championship event is hosted.
- 8.2 If a winner is not present to claim the Prize, he or she will forfeit the Prize and a new winner will be selected until such time a valid winner is found.
- 8.3 If a winner's identity has been verified and there are no grounds for disqualification, the winner will receive the Prize.
- 8.4 We do not accept any alternative arrangement or delay to the claiming of Prizes.

9. ACCEPTANCE OF RISK

- 9.1 Each of the winner and his or her guest acknowledges that the MotoGP World Championship can be a hazardous place and there is an inherent risk of injury by being present in the paddock.
- 9.2 Each of the winner and his or her guest agrees to hold harmless [WePlay Media Dorna Sports] and all partners of this Promotion should either the winner or his or her guest sustain any injury during the enjoyment of the Prize.

10. MINORS REQUIRE A GUARDIAN

- 10.1 As the Prize is open to minors over 12 years of age, should a minor win, an adult guardian must accompany the minor during the enjoyment of the Prize.
- 10.2 Acceptance of liability for a minor will be solely assumed by the adult guardian.

11. OBEY ALL LAWS REGARDING THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

- 11.1 As the Prize is open to minors over 12 years old, the adult guardian must ensure the minor does not break any laws regarding the consumption of alcohol.
