

Treaty of Kyoma

Traktati i Kyomës

1.1 - "Signatories" shall be defined as the Empire of North Eskaeba, the Empire of South Eskaeba and the Republic of Ceredonia.

1.2 - "Treaty" shall be defined as this document, the Treaty of Kyoma.

2.1 - Emperor Proclus I shall step down as Basileus of Eskaeba and renounce all claims to the title.

2.2 - A new Provisional Republic will be set up, and the country will henceforth be known as the Provisional Republic of North Eskaeba (as it will hereinafter be referred to as).

2.3 - The Provisional Republic of North Eskaeba will cede minor border regions to the Empire of South Eskaeba.

2.4 - The Provisional Republic of North Eskaeba will cede the city of Vrosina to the Empire of South Eskaeba.

3.1 - The Empire of South Eskaeba will henceforth be known as the Kingdom of South Eskaeba (as it will hereinafter be referred to as).

3.2 - The Kingdom of South Eskaeba will renounce all claims on the Provisional Republic of North Eskaeba.

3.3 - Michael VIII Theikos will be recognised as the King of South Eskaeba.

4.1 - The Provisional Republic of North Eskaeba and the Kingdom of South Eskaeba will recognise the complete independence and sovereignty of the Republic of Ceredonia.

4.2 - The Provisional Republic of North Eskaeba will return its occupied territory to the Republic of Ceredonia.

4.3 - The Provisional Republic of North Eskaeba will pay reparations totalling 150 million aurums for war crimes committed against the Ceredonian peoples.

5.1 - The Duchy of Kolbau will be established as an independent buffer state, comprising of 70% South Eskaeban and 30% North Eskaeban territory.

6.1 - The new border will henceforth be known as the "2019 Armistice Line".

7.1 - This treaty will act as a binding non-aggression pact between the Provisional Republic of North Eskaeba, Kingdom of South Eskaeba, Republic of Ceredonia and Duchy of Kolbau.
