Course Description

- Instruction and practice will be provided in the following areas: math fact fluency, math computation and problem solving, operations with fractions and decimals, geometry and measurement, and statistics and probability. The class will consist of some whole group, small group, and independent practice.

Grading Policy

- All district gradebooks will utilize a weighted scale. Summative assessments will comprise 60% of a student's quarterly grade, and formative assessments will comprise 40%.
 - Summative assessments = a measure of student learning at the end of an instructional unit (i.e. - Tests, Quizzes, etc.)
 - Formative assessments = an ongoing measure of student learning used by the teacher to guide instruction (i.e. - Classwork, Homework, etc.)

Course Expectations

- Absences
 - Students are responsible for getting any work missed during an absence. Students should check Google Classroom to determine what was covered in class, what new assignments must be completed, and what assignments must be handed in. It is often possible to complete the assignment listed on Google Classroom from home, if the student feels well enough. I am available during WIN for extra help getting caught up.
- Late Work/Make Up Work
 - I will accept late work until the end of the unit or marking period, depending which comes first. A zero will be put into the grade book until the assignment is turned in.
