



Year 3 Parent Information Booklet 2022-23

Reminders

Doors open at 8:45 and school begins at 8.55 am. Please ensure that your child is punctual.

Absence must be reported to the office on the first day.

Following recent government legislation the head teacher cannot sanction family holidays in school time except in exceptional circumstances. This requires a leave of absence form which can be obtained from the school office.

School Uniform consists of red sweatshirt/cardigan, white polo shirt, grey trousers/skirt, black shoes (not trainers). Orders can be placed with school office.

For health and safety reasons we operate a "No Jewellery Policy" other than a watch.

PE Kit consists of white t-shirt, black shorts and trainers or plimsolls.

Children in Year Three have PE on a Thursday afternoon.
Please label all of your child's uniform, including their PE Kit, to help identify any 'lost' property.

How to support your child in Y3

Read with your child daily if possible. Share and discuss books and ask questions about what they are reading.

Help with Maths, English and Reading.

Children should be able to read Year 3 common exception words and write and spell an increasing number of these.

In Maths we are working up to 1000.

In Autumn term we focus on place value and children need to represent, read, write, estimate and compare numbers

-This year children will be taught the 3x, 4x and 8x table.

Concerns

If your child has any problems in class or with homework, speak to the teacher at the earliest opportunity.

If problems occur at home which could affect your child please let school know. This helps us understand changes in attitude/behaviour

If you notice any changes in your child's attitude or behavior which you believe may be caused by bullying let school know as soon as possible.

Homework and Reading

Homework: Your child will bring home a weekly homework task, in addition to their reading book. This will be related to work being carried out in class.

Homework is given to your child on a Friday.

Homework should be completed and returned to the teacher by the following Wednesday.

Each week there will be one written piece of homework and one online piece.

Please support your child with their homework

A child can return their reading book on any day to be changed. Make sure you write in the yellow record book how many times they have read.

During the week your child will read with the class teacher or teaching assistant as well.

If there is anything specific we have been practising this will be shared in the record book.
