Scholarship Program

The following criterion is used for selection and applies for all scholarships except as noted.

1. Must be a graduation-bound senior at Bark River-Harris Schools.
2. Must complete the application procedures as outlined by the selection committee.
3. Must plan to be a full-time student in a post-high school training program.
4. Must show potential for success in the area that they are planning for further training.
5. The further training may be in any field chosen and at any institution that is approved by the selection committee, except as noted.
6. Must be accepted for admission at the institution for post-high school training.
7. Must have attained a minimum GPA of 2.0, except as noted.
8. Must show good moral character.
9. Financial need will be taken into consideration, but will not be considered a controlling factor or a threshold requirement.
10. The amount of each local scholarship to be awarded each year will be determined by the selection committee or awarding entities.
11. Selection shall be done without reference to race, color, or creed of the applicant.
12. The scholarship will be for one year only, unless otherwise stipulated.

You, as a scholarship applicant, are required to submit a 250-500 word statement about your future educational plans. Please include in your statement:

- Which post-secondary institution you plan to attend**
- Your intended major**
- Any community service or volunteer hours that you have completed**
- Any financial needs that you wish to share**
- Several reasons why you would be a good candidate for this scholarship**

First Bank Scholarship

Two \$100 scholarships are given: one to a boy and one to a girl.

Students must have at least four letters from two or more sports with highest class rank and top SAT score.

All graduating seniors are considered for this award. Recipients are determined on the above criteria.

Bronco Award

Two scholarships (dollar amount to be determined annually) donated by Reynold F. Houle: Harris Class of 1939, one to a boy and one to a girl.

The athletes will be selected by the coaches and faculty of Bark River-Harris High School. The athletes selected must be at least an average (C) student, who works hard in the classroom and is a good role model to young children and peers.

All graduating seniors are considered for this award. Recipients are determined on the above criteria.

Leo Brunelle Outstanding Athlete Award

Two scholarships (dollar amount to be determined annually) donated by the Leo Brunelle family are given to two outstanding athletes, one boy and one girl. Mr. Brunelle was in education for many years as a teacher, principal, and coach.

The athletes will be selected by the coaches of Bark River-Harris High School. The athletes selected must have received honors as participating athletes.

All graduating seniors are considered for this award. Recipients are determined on the above criteria.

2. The recipients, upon receipt of the scholarship, will present proof of registration at an accredited college or vocational school.
3. Payment of the scholarship will be made to the recipient in two payments at the beginning of his/her first two semesters/terms of post-secondary education.

Bark River-Harris Student Loan

Purpose- To encourage qualified students within the Bark River-Harris area to seek higher education beyond the secondary level, and to provide financial assistance to a limited number of such students through the awarding of loans.

Requirements for each applicant

1. Resident of Bark River-Harris area (no minimum period required), or graduate from Bark River-Harris School.
2. Acceptance by accredited school of higher learning.
3. Transcript of secondary school grades (if not a BR-H graduate).
4. Completion of application form.
5. Interview with the Student Loan Committee, if requested.
6. Presentation of Financial Need

Maximum amount loaned out - \$500.00

Interest Rate – Interest free for the first year

5% per annum on unpaid balance

Repayment period – Within three years after graduation from college or discontinuance of schooling.

To be paid back according to the following schedule:

1st year 20% of Principal & Accrued Interest

2nd year 30% of Principal & Accrued Interest

3rd year 50% of Principal & Accrued Interest or Balance Due

****If the loan is paid back the first year, it is interest free.**

Actual amount loaned out is dependent upon the number of applicants and balance remaining in the Loan Fund.
