Tenofovir Disoproxil Fumarate (TDF) and its prodrug Tenofovir Alafenamide (TAF): Both TDF and TAF, developed by Gilead Sciences, are nucleotide reverse transcriptase inhibitors (NRTIs). It was evaluated in clinical trials for its effectiveness in treating HIV infection. They are commonly used as part of combination antiretroviral therapy for HIV treatment.

Efavirenz (EFV): EFV, developed by Bristol-Myers Squibb, is a non-nucleoside reverse transcriptase inhibitor (NNRTI). It was one of the first-line treatment options for HIV and is still used in certain situations, although newer NNRTIs have become more commonly prescribed. It was studied in clinical trials as part of combination therapy for HIV.

Darunavir (DRV): DRV, developed by Janssen (a subsidiary of Johnson & Johnson), is a protease inhibitor (PI). It was investigated in clinical trials as part of combination antiretroviral therapy for HIV.

Raltegravir (RAL): RAL, developed by Merck & Co., is an integrase inhibitor. It was one of the first integrase inhibitors approved for HIV treatment and is still used in certain cases, although newer integrase inhibitors have become more prevalent.

Maraviroc (MVC): MVC, developed by Pfizer, is a CCR5 antagonist. It is used as an alternative treatment option in certain cases, particularly when the HIV strain shows susceptibility to CCR5 antagonism.

Enfuvirtide (ENF): ENF, developed by Trimeris and Hoffmann-La Roche, is a fusion inhibitor. It was studied in clinical trials as a medication to prevent the fusion of HIV with host cells.
