

Step 1: find out when the event happened (dates)

Step 2: number the events in chronological order

Step 3: research each event and take notes about

1. Where did the event take place?
2. What caused the event?
3. What happened?
4. What were the effects (Why is this event considered a “cause of the Revolution”?)

Step 4: create a timeline with all of the events, in chronological order, with explanations and a picture to remind you about the event
