**PLAYER AGREEMENT, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, LIABILITY WAIVER AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT,  
MEDICAL CERTIFICATION AND AUTHORIZATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL TREATMENT**

**As the parent of legal guardian of the child named below, in consideration of the agreement of the Brodhead Junior Cardinal Youth Baseball Program (BJCYB) to allow my child to participate in the programs and play on the fields offered by BJCYB, I hereby agree as follows.**

- 1. Consent to Participate.** I hereby give my full consent and approval for my child to participate in all programs offered by the BJCYBP.
- 2. Acknowledgement and Assumption of Risks.** I understand that there are certain risks of damages and injuries, including death, that are inherent in the games of baseball and softball, and that activities that take place during each and every practice and game are hazardous, including, but not limited to, pitching, throwing, fielding and catching the ball, swinging of the bat, running, jumping, stretching, sliding, diving and colliding with other players and with stationary objects, as well as other risks posed by travel, weather, player conditions, equipment and/or other participants. On behalf of my child and myself, I

do voluntarily elect to accept and solely assume all risks of injury incurred or suffered by my child (a) while participating in the BJCYBP, (b) while serving in a non-playing capacity as team member or observer during any activity conducted as part of the BJCYBP, and (c) while on or upon the premises of any and all of the fields arranged for by the BJCYBP for practice or play.

3. **Liability Waiver and Hold Harmless Agreement.** In addition to giving my full consent for my child's participation, I do hereby waive, release, discharge and agree not to sue the BJCYBP, the owner or operator of any fields on which the BJCYBP teams play, any baseball or softball organization with whom the BJCYBP affiliates, and all their owners, officers, agents, servants, associations, employees, and any person or entity connected with the BJCYBP (the "Released Parties"), for any claim, damages, costs including attorneys' fees, and causes of action which I or my child have or may have in the future as a result of damages, injuries, including death, sustained or incurred by my child from whatever cause including but not limited to the negligence, breach of contract or wrongful conduct of the Released Parties. I further agree on behalf of myself and my child listed below, that I shall forever hold harmless and fully indemnify the Released Parties from any and all claims, damages, costs including attorney fees, and causes of action which may arise from my child's participation in the BJCYBP, even if the damages, injuries or death are caused in whole or in part by any of the Released Parties.
4. **Medical Certification.** I hereby certify that my child is fully capable of participating in the BJCYBP and that my child is healthy and has no physical or mental disabilities or infirmities that would restrict full participation in the BYBP, except as made known to coaches and officials of the BYBP.
5. **Authorization for Emergency Medical Treatment.** I understand that the BJCYBP will make every effort to contact me in case of an emergency requiring medical attention for my child. However, if I cannot be reached, I hereby authorize the to BJCYBP administer First Aid, to arrange transportation to the nearest hospital and/or health care facility, and to secure any necessary medical or dental treatment, and that I will be responsible financially for the reasonable cost of each assistance and/or treatment.

#### **CONCUSSION AGREEMENT REQUIRED BY WISCONSIN LAW**

**As the parent or legal guardian of the child named below, in consideration of the agreement of the Brodhead Junior Cardinal Youth Baseball Program (BJCYBP) to allow my child to participate in the programs and play on the fields offered by the BJCYB, I hereby agree as follows.**

1. **Concussion Agreement Required by Wisconsin Law.** I acknowledge that I have read the Wisconsin Concussion Fact Sheet for Parents provided by the BYBP and understand what a concussion is and how it may be caused. I also understand the common signs, symptoms, and behaviors. I agree that my child must be removed from practice/play if a concussion is suspected. I understand that it is my responsibility to seek medical treatment if a suspected concussion is reported to me. I understand that my child cannot return to practice/play until providing written clearance from an appropriate health care provider to his/her coach. I understand the possible consequences of my child returning to practice/play too soon.

#### **CONSENT TO USE OF PLAYER LIKENESS**

**Consent and Authorization to Use of Player's Likeness.** I agree that my child may be filmed and photographed while participating in the BYBP by any photographer authorized by the BYBP, and that the BYBP may use such film or photograph of my child to promote the events and activities of the BYBP.

#### **BJCYB PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT**

The Brodhead Junior Cardinal Youth Baseball Program (BJCYB) has implemented the following Sport Parent Code of Conduct because of the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in sports.

All parents who register a child to participate on any team or in any program operated by the BJCYB must abide by this Code of Conduct at all times. All parents should read and understand this form prior to registering a child to participate in our programs.

Any adult guilty of improper conduct at any game or practice will be asked to leave the sports facility and be suspended from the following game. Repeat and/or severe violations may cause a multiple game suspension and/or the forfeiture of the privilege of attending all games or so long as the BJCYBP deems appropriate.

#### **Preamble**

The essential elements of character-building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six core principles: (1) Trustworthiness, (2) Respect, (3) Responsibility, (4) Fairness, (5) Caring, and (6) Good Citizenship.

The highest potential of sports is achieved when competition reflects these “six pillars of character.”

**As the parent or legal guardian of the child named below, in consideration of the agreement of the Brodhead Junior Cardinal Youth Baseball Program (BJCYB) to allow my child to participate in the program and play on the fields offered by the BJCYB, I hereby agree as follows:**

1. I will not force my child to participate in sports.
2. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
3. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
4. I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
5. I and my guests will be a positive role model for my child and will encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
6. I and my guests will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing or taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and wellbeing of the athletes.
8. I will teach my child to play by the rules and resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
9. I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with the respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
10. I will teach my child that doing one’s best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
11. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
12. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
13. I will emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit my child over winning. I will also de-emphasize games and competition in the lower age groups.
14. I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
15. I will respect the umpires and their authority during games. I will refrain from speaking with and making any comments to or about any umpire during any game unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
16. I will respect the coaches and their authority during games, will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
17. I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all sports events.
18. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.

**As the parent or legal guardian of the child named below, in consideration of the agreement of the Brodhead Junior Cardinal Youth Baseball (BJCYB) to allow my child to participate in the programs and play on the fields offered by the BJCYB, I hereby agree as follows:**

The Brodhead Junior Cardinal Youth Baseball Program remains committed to provide our children with an excellent program. This is only possible with the time and investment not only of the children, but also of the parents or guardian. The BJCYBP has always had the best intentions for the children and this continues to be a foundation as we move forward. A few of our major accomplishments over the past years include: **helmets, catcher’s equipment, pitching machines, batting cage, lighting, playground equipment, fencing, infield sod, bleachers, dugout roofs, uniforms, outdoor matting for batting cages, L-screens, fence capping, trees and the playing surface.**

#### **Important Notes**

1. No Refunds will be given
