Year 11 Parents Evening: Wednesday 31st January 2024 4.00pm – 7.00pm

Please book your appointment time as soon as possible, these will be made on a **'first-come, first-served'** basis and need to be made by **Friday 26th January at the very latest**

Intervention & Exam practice

This is a crucial time for your child with only 4 months until their GCSE exams begin. To support your child in their preparation for these exams we will continue the exam practice programme until Monday 29th April. The exam practice programme will continue to run on Mondays from 2:30pm until 3:30pm led by your child's tutor;

Our intervention programme has in previous years had a significant impact on final grades. Attendance is therefore vital and students will be at a real disadvantage if they fail to attend. The after school intervention will continue every Tuesday and Thursday (15:10 - 16:10) until 2nd May. We expect all students to make 100% effort and to have the correct attitude towards the work in order to get the most out of the sessions.
