6. *Tree of woe double stomp*
7. *Repeatedly hits kneeling opponent's head with brass knuckles + Snap brainbuster combo*

9. *Dropkick (running, springboard, top-rope versions)*

Preferred Weapon: Spiked brass knuckles

Specialty Match Type: Uncharted Grounds match

This is his signature stipulation as MWE Lockdown Champion. It is designed to reflect his violent underground fighting roots, general bitterness and need for absolute control over his opponents.

Key Features:

- **Anywhere/Anytime Start:** The fight can begin anywhere in the arena (or even outside it), without warning. The match can break out backstage, at the merch stand, in the parking lot. No place is safe.
- **Falls Count Anywhere Rules:** Anything goes. No disqualifications. No countouts.
- **Hidden Weapons & Traps:** Lukas plants secret weapons and makeshift traps throughout the arena—steel pipes, barbed bats, broken doll parts, even brass knuckles. Competitors don't know what's waiting for them until they stumble upon it.
- **Final Fight Pit:** No matter where the chaos starts, the match must end inside a designated fight pit. This pit is surrounded by The Division (or whoever Lukas brings) and anyone his opponent wants to bring (3 maximum), acting like lumberjacks who ensure nobody escapes. The pit itself resembles his underground fighting past: low barricades, chains and a claustrophobic, gladiator-like atmosphere.
- **Win Condition:** The match can only end by knockout or referee stoppage—there are no pins or submissions. The fight continues until one competitor can no longer continue.

Background:

Lukas grew up in Sacramento, CA, before his mother took the kids out one night during his high school freshman year, dropped them off at his maternal grandmother's place in the suburbs of Las Vegas and never came back. His father was an abusive, angry drunk and his mother had sunk into depression. He then lived with his Oma and two sisters (one is his fraternal twin Helena and the other, Freya, just five years old).

Soon enough, Lukas cleaned up and stepped up to take care of his family when Oma's health started declining and his father returned to manipulate and extort money from him to support his dark lifestyle. Helena herself took off on her own to search for their still missing mother. In the

middle of all this, Lukas found comfort and purpose in the safe walls of Nightfall Fights where he trained with Xavier Young and also reunited with his childhood best friend Gavin.

Over the years, he signed with various places like Inferno Wrestling, HKW Underground and Liberty Pro (Empire Pro). Though he worked hard and received opportunities, his wrestling career has never exactly flourished the way he had hoped. Despite getting the chance to compete in title tournaments here and there, he has never made it far enough. And even though the past 2 years had been great to him, marrying his soulmate and working a lighter schedule in the independent circuit after Empire Pro closed, he still craves for more. As a result, he has grown more and more frustrated with his professional life.

Still feeling stuck and itching for a championship, just to satisfy that hunger inside, he is determined to do another run. This time at Millennium Wrestling. It wasn't smooth sailing and it captured the attention of one Julian Savell, leader of The Division. Lukas was skeptical at first and declined Julian's invite to join the faction. Instead, he accepted his best friend Gavin Grimes' help (also his in-ring return) in a tag team match against Rainer and Karen Nordhagen. Unfortunately, it all went downhill so fast the moment Gavin accidentally smashed Sophie with a steel chair when Karen ducked. Sophie immediately collapsed and left bleeding from impact. Lukas abandoned the match to carry her out of there and far from Gavin, believing it was all his fault. Lukas was so angry that he refused to let Gavin visit Sophie in the hospital till she woke up and asked for him. Following that, Lukas officially joined Julian in The Division by attacking a vulnerable Gavin in the middle of the ring and became one of the trainers in Crucible Academy where his younger sister Freya one day turned up to train. Not long after that at Written in the Stars Night 1 in January, Lukas captured his first ever championship of his career, the Lockdown championship, thanks to a mysterious teddy bear containing a hidden teaser that was thrown from the stands during the Lockdown championship match against the then-champ Selena Lyre, Gabriel Landry and Angelica Jones.

The fight between Lukas and Gavin affected everyone around them, especially Helena when he took it out on her for abandoning him every time she went on her searches for their long lost mother in the past, Sophie after her own brother decided to cut ties with her and forbade her from seeing his newly discovered son, and then later Ava when Abel attacked her during Lukas' first Lockdown Championship defence where she was the challenger and she ended up in a coma for a while. Lukas regretted bringing him onboard as one of the Division lumberjacks in the Uncharted Grounds match because it further broke Sophie. It also affected Freya because she couldn't accept nor understand why Lukas got mad at her boyfriend for helping him win. Eventually, Lukas and Gavin met in another Uncharted Grounds match where Sophie became the special guest referee and ended up helping Lukas win, officially aligning herself with him and The Division against her brother.

The war between The Division and Supremacy heated up suddenly when Chris Night fired back for the first time ever after Julian injured JJ. Julian ended up in the hospital, forcing Olly to step up as head trainer. This also caused added tension between Chris and Lukas where the veteran insinuated that Lukas was still the same troubled kid from years ago looking for a father figure in

him back in Nightfall. Then at the Nexus tournament Convergence, Chris and his son CJ brutally attacked Helena after their match just to send a message to Lukas and The Division. The two factions exchanged more violent attacks involving not just the trainers but also the students, leading to a huge showdown at Crucible's Livewire supershow where The Division ended up winning.

Around this same time, Lukas found another thorn in his side: the Kross family. Particularly his old rival Kendrick and his younger half brother Jayson in Crucible. Lukas still remembered their bitter feud over the Anarchy championship back in Liberty Pro, the same championship that was revived in Crucible. He never forgot how Kendrick used to gloat about winning and keeping the championship from Lukas while hurting Sophie in the process. He had never been able to get his revenge because Liberty Pro closed shortly after. And now that Kendrick has won the number one contender's spot for the Lockdown championship, Lukas is more than ready to be the one that knocks.

Lukas' other current rival is Romero Silas in Slaughterhouse Wrestling and it's been constant trading of run-in attacks, stabbing and leaving each other bleeding at every show for months. Unlike other rivalries, this one is strictly a professional one and it all started because Lukas thought Romero was being too dismissive of him after their first match against each other. This was when Lukas first became the Lockdown champion and he was offended that Romero didn't seem to take him seriously as a Slaughterhouse wrestler who was still finding his footing there.

Meanwhile, things have not settled between The Division and Supremacy yet as a new storm is brewing. Supremacy students Razor Wolf and Baby Monroe attacked MWE Academy student Raya Inella, prompting Olly to exact revenge on Supremacy trainer Megan Monroe. Then Supremacy answered back with coordinated attacks on The Division students by Supremacy students Marshall Rozzi, Adelita Castro and siblings Tyler and Savannah Kincaid.
