Using SeeSaw, choose the drawing button and draw a scene that you visualized as you read today. Make sure to include the setting and characters.	Using pencil and paper, draw a scene that you visualized as you read today. Make sure to include the setting and characters. Take a picture of your illustration and upload it to SeeSaw.	Act out a scene from your assigned reading today and record it on SeeSaw using the video option.
Record yourself on SeeSaw giving a summary of the assigned reading today. Make sure you include all the essential details from the story. It is important you use the characters' names, tell the setting, and the events that are crucial to the main idea of the story.	Using the notepad on SeeSaw, write about a connection you made to your assigned reading today. Make sure you explain how the two connect. Example: In the story (explain what happened) and this reminds me of (discuss your text connection)	Using SeeSaw, use the notepad and write a journal entry from the perspective of the main character of your story. Make sure you focus on your main character's feelings, actions, and dialogue from your assigned reading today.
