WHO WE ARE

The Colorado Farmers Market Association, FrontLine Farming, Colorado Food Systems Advisory Council, LiveWell Colorado, CSU Extension, the National Western Center, City and County of Denver-Good Food Purchasing Program, Rocky Mountain Farmers Union, Colorado Food Pantry Network, The Good Food Collective, Mile High Farmers, Colorado Department of Agriculture, Rocky Mountain Local Food, and National Young Farmers Coalition (and YOU!) have joined together to create a state project team to support farmers and ranchers in responding to changing market opportunities in the midst of COVID-19.

We understand that the current situation is changing market access and performance of farmers and ranchers. As this team works to support Colorado farmers and ranchers as they respond to the new ways in which households and institutions are acquiring and purchasing food, we want to make sure that all Colorado producers are equitably connected to resources and market connections. Our team is focused on supporting producers that utilize non-commodity markets, given that other resources exist that are specifically targeted to specific commodities. Further, though our team works to support all producers, we are making an effort to account for the specific needs of small- and mid- size growers, direct market farms, beginning farmers and ranchers, veteran farmers, farmers of color, and female farmers.

We will mobilize with an eye toward the future, and to addressing immediate needs while contributing to the longer-term resiliency of our local and regional food systems. We are also committed to identifying and supporting market channels for producers that help move healthy foods to those who need it most in their communities.

To Do This We Will:

- 1. Listen & Learn what's happening in local & regional food systems right now:
 - a. Develop a system for aggregating the many value-chain oriented surveys and listening session happening across the state
- 2. Assess & Understand themes in the struggles/challenges and assets/resources of our partners:
 - a. Analyze various surveys collected and develop direction about common assets, needs, and gaps in information (who have we not heard from?)
- **3. Make Connections** between each other, advocacy groups, local emergency response teams, state agencies, and from growers to buyers:
 - a. Host platforms for connecting across the state (see below)
 - b. Develop a web-based tool to match growers to buyers
 - c. Aggregate and provide easy access to the many emerging resources for local and regional food systems
- 4. Act & Mobilize around these themes through policy advocacy and other actions
 - a. Educate and mobilize around relevant Federal policy actions
 - Capture critical needs and make recommendations to the state via the Colorado Food Systems Advisory Council
- **5. Link to Financial Resources** through three primary means:
 - a. Develop a rapid-response mini-grant fund
 - b. Connect local food systems stakeholders to existing USDA programs and other funding
 - c. Assess and mobilize around relevant stimulus opportunities for food systems to ensure these dollars are effectively utilized
