Information	We recommend iReady testing towards the middle/end of this window to give students time and opportunity to receive best first instruction.  Initial READ Plans for Kindergarten students who are at or below the cut score and qualify for a READ Plan (please refer to READ Act Identification flowcharts below), need created no later than November 10th (first 90 calendar days of the school year), but can be created sooner. Most importantly-adjust instruction immediately and begin progress monitoring. The READ Act allows for 90 days from the beginning of a kindergartener's school year to determine a root cause, write a READ plan, and begin to provide instruction. November 10, 2023 is 90 calendar days after the first day of kindergarten.  Create a READ Intervention Plan by using all data in collaboration with your school's READ team and the student's family. Collaborate with families to create the at-home reading plan.
