First Half Match report Huddersfield TownH v Fleetwood Town

Tyreese Simpson scores on his debut as Huddersfield draw 3-3 against Fleetwood

- Three first half goals for Towns B team
- Goals for Simpson on his B team debut
- Standard Ben Jackson goal on the edge of the box

Simpson's first game for the B team and he took the team from 1-0 down to 2-1 up. His good link up plays with 6"9 striker Hudlin was an outlet that was utilised effectively in the first half

Our B team initially went 1-0 down in the 4th minute as the defence were caught out with the ball just inside their own half. Will Russ capitalises and squares the ball across the box one on one with Michael Roxburgh and Max McMillan taps it in.

Simpson gets a chance in the 12th minute from Hudlin squaring the ball across the box just behind Simpson who cannot shape his body in time and scuffs his shot.

In the 22nd minute Hudlin gets a shot off on the left side of the 6-yard box and the keeper parries it for Harrat to tap it in to equalise for the Terriers.

Getting into the 33rd minute Mahoney worked a good ball across the box for Simpson to finish with a first-time finish.

The ball is crossed into the box from the right-hand side from Mahoney and bounces around the edge of the box, coming out to Jackson who hits it first time from the edge of the box and goes into the bottom right corner. Resulting in the fourth goal of the half at the 42nd goal.

The first half ended 3-1.
