French and Indian War/Seven Years' War Response

For next class, you will need to **write 1 page** in response to the following prompt:

The Seven Years' War (also known as the French and Indian War) influenced the lives of different groups of people very differently. Choose one of the following groups and explain how this group was affected during and after the war. What changed for these people? What stayed the same?

- British Colonists in the 13 Colonies
- French Colonists in Canada
- Native People of Canada
- The Iroquois Confederacy
- The British Government
- The French Government

Your response should include a **clear thesis**, at least **two body paragraphs** with clear **topic sentences**. You should also be citing your sources (including your class notes and the textbook).

Remember some guidelines for writing:

- Always make sure that you are being clear about how what you are writing connects to your thesis.
- Write simply and clearly; clarity is more important than style in academic writing.
- Make sure you are using specific examples to illustrate your points; without an example, your writing is only half done!

You should not need to do much outside research. The following websites should be used if you need further information for your response:
