

Woolly Friends

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Supplies

- **Stamp Sets:** Woolly Friends (166881):
- Jolly Holly Bundle (166888): Woolly Friends Builder Punch (166887)
- **Paper:** Basic Black (121045): Pretty in Pink (163793): Basic White (159276):
- **Stamp Pads:** Tuxedo Black Memento Ink:(132708): Pretty in Pink (163807):
- **Tools:** Woolly Friends Builder Punch (166887); Nested Essentials Dies (161597); Basics WOW! Embossing Powder (165679): Heat Tool US (129053)
- **Miscellaneous:** Baker's Twine Essentials Pack (155475; 2025-2027 In Color Flat Pearls (165192): Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755): Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' UP! Cut & Emboss Machine (149653)



Measurements

- Basic Black C/S: 8 ½" x 5 ½" , 5 ¼"x 4"
- Pretty in Pink C/C: 5 ¼"x 4" and a scrap for die cutting
- Basic White: 5"x 3 ¾" and scraps for Sheep

Instructions:

1. Fold the Basic Black card base at 4 ¼" and burnish.
2. Stamp the sheep all over the Basic White cardstock piece in Memento Black.
3. Adhere this piece onto the Pretty in Pink layer using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Attach the layered piece to the card base using Dimensionals.
5. Using the *smallest die* from the Nested Essentials Dies and the scrap of Pretty in Pink, run it through your Cut & Emboss Machine to create the triangle.
6. On the triangle, stamp the sentiment with VersaMark.
7. Sprinkle with White Embossing Powder and heat to set.
8. Trim the triangle as needed and adhere it to the card front over the stamped sheep image.
9. Stamp the sheep's body in Memento onto a scrap piece of Basic White. Stamp the face separately.
10. Stamp the body again, this time using Pretty in Pink, and punch it out with the coordinating punch. Layer and assemble the pieces using Dimensionals.
11. Adhere onto the left-hand side of the triangle piece.
12. Tie a small bow using Black Twine and adhere it under the sheep's chin.
13. • Finish the card by adding pearls for a polished touch.
