

# **FLAG TAG**

## **OBJECTIVE:**

Try to knock out the opposing players by running around and grabbing their flags. A player is only knocked out once both flags are pulled. The last team with flags still attached wins!

## **SUPPLIES NEEDED:**

1. One bucket per team
2. Pinnies / ribbon to designate teams (Or make the Flags for each team a different color)
3. Clothes pins and Durable Ribbon that won't rip or tear easy to create the flags, or purchase flag football flags. However, I recommend making the flags, as it is much less expensive and not too difficult to make (instructions on making the flags are below).
4. High energy background music during gameplay (optional but Recommended)

## **TEAMS:**

2 or more teams

## **RECOMMENDED SETUP:**

1. Purchase or make the flags ahead of time (instructions below)
2. Pass out two flags to each player and have them attach them to each side of their shirt (one on the left, and one on the right).
3. Separate into 2 or more teams designated by either pinnies or the color of their FLAGS.
4. Place a bucket in each team's designated starting area. You are now all ready to play!


## **HOW TO PLAY:**

1. On GO, each team will run around attempting to grab the other team's flags.
2. Once they successfully grab a flag, they need to run back to their bucket and place the flag in the bucket and continue play.
3. If a player loses both flags, they must then sit in place and are considered OUT. You may not move around and must either sit or kneel.
4. However, even those that are OUT can still play. If an unsuspecting victim... I mean player gets too close, they are able to attempt to grab a player's flags to get them out.
5. Players that are OUT, must do this ONLY from a sitting or kneeling position, and are NOT allowed to move around from their spot.
6. Play until there is only one team left.

### INSTRUCTIONS ON MAKING YOUR FLAGS:

1. Get all the supplies: "Clothes Pins", "Velcro", "Flag / Ribbon Material (One color per team").
2. Cut the Flag / Ribbon material into pieces that are around 12 - 15 inches in length.
3. Stick one side of the Velcro onto the Clothes pin.
4. Stick the other half of the Velcro onto one of the ends of a Flag / Ribbon.
5. You now have now created your Flag Tag "Flags".

**\*\*Make enough Flags for each student to have two flags each of the same color\*\***

**\*\*\*Plan ahead to make the Flags, you wouldn't want to make them last minute, however once they are made you can reuse them over and over again the next time you play\*\*\***
