

# IAR and ISA State Testing Parent Information

Dear 3rd-6th Parents and Guardians,

Elementary students in grades 3rd-6th will take the state mandated Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR):

- March 5th - March 12th

IAR Testing will consist of 3 Math Units and 2 Language Arts Units. Students may take up to two units per day.

**ONLY 5th grade** students will take the Illinois Science Assessment (ISA):

- Elementary: April 15th - April 17th

ISA Testing will consist of 3 Science Units. Students will complete one unit per day.

**\*\*\*It is imperative that all students be in attendance for all testing dates.\*\*\***

**Please make sure your child is ready to test utilizing the following reminders:**

- Be sure that your student is present each day and has no other appointments scheduled during these dates/times.
- They get a good night's sleep and breakfast each day.
  - Breakfast is always served here at school starting at 7:35 AM
- Their chromebooks are charged each night prior to testing as the tests are all computer based.
- They have a set of **corded** earphones or **corded** earbuds to connect to their chromebooks with them daily.
  - Wireless or bluetooth will not work

Our students should feel confident showing what they know and can do on the Illinois Assessment of Readiness and the Illinois Science Assessment.
