Criteria:

- ✓ Must be a graduating senior from Bartlett High School.
- ✓ Must be graduating with a minimum 2.0 GPA.
- ✓ Must have participated in Bartlett High School’s Theatre Program for a minimum of three years and, therefore, inducted into the BHS Thespian Society.
- ✓ Recommended: Majoring in Theatre or a related field including, but not limited to, Acting, Technical Theatre, Theatre Design, Musical Theatre, Fine Arts, Directing, Theatre Education, and Speech Communications. Other academic majors will also be considered.
- ✓ Recommended: Served as a Drama Club Officer and/or held a Leadership position (Student Director, Stage Manager, Student Designer, Organized a Drama Club Activity, etc.).
- ✓ Must submit one letter of recommendation from a Bartlett High School staff member. It cannot be a letter written by Mr. Miserendino, Mr. Blinstrup, Mr. Goldman, Mrs. Mount, Mr. Hollaway, Ms. Larson, Mrs. Pietro, or Mrs. Crone.
- ✓ Must type an essay explaining why you should be the recipient of the Bartlett High School Thespian Scholarship. See below for specific requirements.
