Organic Agriculture Objective:

1. Determine the causes of climate change.

MAIN CONCEPT AND SKILLS

Climate change refers to any significant change in measures of climate (such as temperature, precipitation or wind) lasting for an extended period (decades or longer). Climate change may result from:

Natural factors, such as changes in the sun's intensity or slow changes in the earth's orbit around the sun;

Natural processes within the climate system(e.g. Changes in ocean circulation.)

Human activities that change the atmosphere's composition (e.g. Through burning fossil fuel) and the land surfaces.

Global Warming is an average increase in the temperature of the atmosphere near the Earth's surface and in the troposphere, which can contribute to changes in global climate patterns. Global warming can occur from a variety of causes, both natural and human induced or common , "global warming" often refers to the warming that can occur as a result of increased emission of greenhouse gasses from human activities.

Carbon Footprints

It is an estimate of how much carbon dioxide is produced to support your lifestyle. It is a measure of your impact on the climate based on how much carbon dioxide you produced. Factors that contribute to your carbon footprint include your travel methods and general home energy usage.
