Treasurer's Report

1. Budget recap

We were supposed to vote on the budget in the beginning of September.

2. Proposed Budget for 2022-2023

The budget has been aligned to how we voted last year. Funds for staffing, funds for fun, funds for the future, funds for projects and requests. We are estimating we are needing \$45,000 for the year for these items. Megan S added dollars for PTO operations. Rachel said that the STEM/STEAM night will be an added expense of 1,445 because it is a free event (The Works museum is coming in to do the activity). Only Feb 6 or 8 is available for the STEM/STEAM night. There is a company (Fun2Raise) that will print out the directory for us for free.
